## Economy

Our 21<sup>st</sup> century economic plan:

- returns more than **\$2.7 trillion** to the American people;
- allows all Americans to spend, save, invest and give away their money as they choose;
- stimulates economic activity at the local, county, and state level, resulting in increased tax revenues, and;
- reduces the size of the Federal government by 60% by eliminating failing programs, along with those programs and agencies that are not authorized by the Constitution.

## Taxes

The Party's taxing philosophy is this:

***“Rich, poor, or somewhere in between, if you breathe our air, drink our water, use our roads, and sleep under the blanket of security provided by our military, you should pay a tax.”***

The plan is to eliminate our current, complex, confiscatory income tax system and return to the indirect and direct taxing methods provided in the Constitution.

## Government Spending

The plan reduces the size of the Federal government by 60%, starting with the elimination of almost 500 government programs that fail to meet their objectives, as measured by the OMB's Program Assessment Rating Tool (P.A.R.T.). The additional savings will come from the elimination of all programs/agencies that are not enumerated in Article I, Section 8 of the Constitution.

## Education

Eliminate the Department of Education, which is not provided for in the Constitution. The education of the population is the responsibility of the States, which will have adequate funds to do so from the increased tax revenues generated from the economic activity of their wealthier population.

## **Energy**

Use all of America's natural resources to provide adequate energy for an ever-expanding population, facilitate economic growth, and ensure the world's highest standard of living for the People.

- Build nuclear power plants.
- Develop wind and solar power where practical.

The result will be a reduction in America's dependence on foreign sources of energy.

Furthermore, as a global benefit, when we use less of the world's energy resources, those resources become available for developing nations, thereby increasing the standard of living and improving the lives of billions of people.

## **Gun Control**

We support the God-given right of the American People to bear arms.

We support the death penalty for treason, sedition and other heinous crimes.

## **Immigration Policies**

- Enforce the Federal immigration laws.
- Build the fence.
